Jim May has been the Planning Director for the Centre Regional Planning Agency (CRPA) since June 2009. As Planning Director of the CRPA, Jim has led the 2013 Update to the Centre Region Comprehensive Plan.

The Centre Region Comprehensive Plan is a document that is used to develop a plan for the physical growth of the region; to prepare goals, objectives and policies and to develop a program to implement those goals, objectives and policies. The Comprehensive Plan is used to help guide decisions regarding the civil and natural environment of the region over the next 20 to 30 years. The long-range perspective of the Comprehensive Plan helps provide a coordinated approach when making many decisions regarding land uses, the location of development, protection of sensitive or critical areas, the extension of urban services and investments in community services such as parks. The Comprehensive Plan is one of the primary tools used by the Centre Regional Planning Commission and the General Forum when making decisions that affect the future of the region.

Jim's presentation will focus specifically on Stormwater Management goals within the Centre Region Comprehensive Plan.
