Walt grew up in State College. He obtained his BS in Geology from Penn State University, and then his MS in Hydrogeology from Penn State University under Dick Parizek. Walt then went on to earn his PhD in Geology from the University of Colorado while working for the US Geological Survey.

After obtaining his PhD, Walt taught in the Geology Department at Allegheny College. He founded a groundwater consulting firm in State College known as Nittany Geoscience. Through the work of him and his colleagues in the 1990s, the State College Borough Water Authority tripled their well and well field capacity.

Walt has since retired, and now serves on the board of the University Area Joint Authority, our local sewer authority.
