Walt grew up in State College, earned two degrees in geology from Penn State, with an MS focusing on hydrogeology and received a PhD in geology at the University of Colorado. He worked for the USGS and at the Geology Department of Allegheny College before returning to State College to start his own hydrogeologic consulting business, Nittany Geoscience. The business worked both on developing wells for industries and municipalities and controlling and cleaning up groundwater contamination at industrial sites. During the 1990s the business more than doubled the wellfield capacity of the State College Borough Water Authority. In 1998 Walt sold the business, stayed on for three years to get staff integrated into the acquiring entity, and retired in 2001. Now, Walt serves on the board of UAJA, the local sewer authority.
